Standing Rules

The Northridge East Neighborhood Council establishes these Standing Rules pursuant to its Bylaws. After consideration and possible recommendation by the NENC Bylaws Committee and/or the NENC Executive Committee, a Standing Rule may be adopted, amended, or repealed at any regular Board meeting by the affirmative vote of at least eight (8) Board members.

5.7 Governing Board Absences

A Board member or Alternate who may arrive late to or leave early from any Board meeting should notify the Presiding Officer at least one (1) full day before that meeting, or as soon thereafter as it is known. *(added 2/18/2026)*

5.8.1 Censure

A motion to Censure shall be delivered to all NENC officers: President, 1st Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. *(added 2/18/2026)*

5.9.1 Removal of Governing Board Members

A proposed motion to remove a Board member shall be delivered to all NENC officers: President, 1st Vice-President, 2nd Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. *(added 2/18/2026)*

7.1 Standing Committees

The Standing Committees are: Beautification and Weed Abatement; Education; Executive; Finance; Homelessness; Outreach; Planning and Land Use; Public Safety; and Sustainability. *(revised 2/18/2026)*

The responsibilities of all Standing Committees are to make recommendations on subjects under their purview or on matters referred to them by the Board. *(4/19/2017)*

7.3.C Committee Appointment

Committee reports shall be provided at least twice annually, at the end of the Fiscal Year (June) and the calendar year (December).

All Committee Chairs or Co-Chairs should research Council Files, including City Council motions and departmental reports, related to their committee's subject matter jurisdiction at least on a quarterly basis. *(added 2/18/2026)*

8.1 Meeting Time and Place

The Board will hold its regular meetings on the third Wednesday of every month beginning at 7:00 p.m. virtually via Zoom or in-person at the Northridge Woman's Club, 18401 Lassen Street, Northridge, or at another location within the NENC boundaries as specified on the meeting agenda. 8.3 Meeting Notifications/Postings

There are two 24/7 physical posting locations for all meeting agendas: Northridge Recreation Center (north entrance facing the street), 18300 Lemarsh Street, Northridge and Northridge Branch Library (near the main entrance), 9051 Darby Avenue, Northridge. (4/19/2017; revised 11/17/2021)
