"The Northridge East Neighborhood Council urges passage of the 'Holding GHCHS Accountable to Their Charter' resolution which has been submitted to the LAUSD School Board for consideration."

Approximately seven supporters of Granada Hills Charter High School (GHCHS) spoke in opposition to the proposed motion. Some of the arguments provided were:

- No one had proven that they had been an actual victim of GHCHS' policies.
- Not every school should be required to serve every type of special need.
- GHCHS' Executive Director has told them that they do not have a responsibility to serve every child from the former attendance area of Granada Hills High School.
- That the LAUSD has already cleared GHCHS so no further action should be taken

The supporters of GHCHS promised to set up a meeting between members of the committee and the GHCHS' Executive Director. The item was tabled till the next meeting so that this discussion could take place.

6. Discuss the "Public Forum to Discuss Traffic and Pedestrian Safety Issues on Zelzah Avenue and the proposed CSUN Multi-Story Parking Structure Abutting Northridge Academy High School" that was held on May 18, 2019.

Tabled to a future meeting.

7. Update on any outstanding funding issues including NENC Boards vote to re-approve NPG ot Northridge Academy High School for sets of young adult books for school library in the amount of \$1,900.
