Received an update from Tara Vahdani, School Engagement and Data Specialist from the Office of Board Member Scott M. Schmerelson:

- There are 63 centers throughout the district
- 17 are in the San Fernando Valley
- Porter Middle School, Sepulveda Middle School, Kennedy High School and Chatsworth High School are the closest to Northridge East.
- Two meals are provided.
- No ID is required.
- Recipients do not need to have been receiving subsidized meals before the shutdown.
- Food boxes are provided with shelf-stable items.

Requested support: spread word about the existence of the Grab and Go Centers.
