Updated on the motion passed by the NENC Education Committee: The Education Committee recommends that the Northridge East Neighborhood Council (NENC) encourages a complete investigation of the student assault at Granada Hills Charter School (GHCS) on October 31, 2022. Families within the NENC boundaries attend GHCS. It is imperative that parents be kept up to date on the status of this investigation and the steps being taken to ensure their children's safety.

11. Update on the motion passed by the NENC Education Committee: The Northridge East Neighborhood Council is concerned about dangerous traffic conditions on Plummer St. and Praire St. and other streets around our local schools including Dearborn Elementary Charter Academy and Oliver Wendell Holmes Middle School. We call on the city to increase enforcement of traffic and parking laws and to fully fund the crossing guard program to help protect students traveling to and from school safely.

Enforcement action was taken. This was discussed on Nextdoor with a mostly positive response.

Unsafe traffic conditions still exist.

12. Update on the motion passed by the NENC Education Committee: The NENC expresses concern about the contract signed between the LAUSD and the Florida Virtual School, an entity controlled by the Florida Department of Education. We urge the City of Los Angeles to investigate and scrutinize the origins of this contract, the way in which the Florida Department of Education was selected, and the process followed for the approval of the contract. Further, it should be evaluated whether this contract meets the educational standards of the State of California and if it violates the civil rights of Los Angeles students.
